## **Mr Chandrashekhar Tilak**

In her introductory notes Dr Vaidehi Daptardar principal, Adarsh College brought forward the objectives of RSVP, 'Re-orienting, Restructuring and Rejuvenating Indian social science to suit Indian values and culture is one of the major objectives of RSVP. She explained the need of organising a speech on such a controversial yet relevant current issue like Chinese Aggression in the present scenario of the topic background.

Dr. Manasi Gore gave a brief but very concise introduction of Mr. Chandrashekhar Tilak and the various

In his inaugural speech, Mr. Tilak examined the issues of Chinese aggression from different angles. He analysed why in recent years India became the main rival or opponent of China. In this speech, he analysed border issues, economic issues which are the major reasons for conflict between China and India.
