3. Economic Reforms - The Unfinished Agenda.

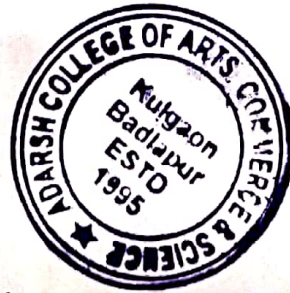
