#### World Wide Web Day

#### Workshop on "How to Use AI and Create Presentations Using AI"

Date: 04<sup>th</sup> August 2025

On 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025, the occasion of World Wide Web Day, Department Of Information Technology organized Workshop on "How to Use AI and Create Presentations Using AI". The session introduced tools for content generation, design assistance, and presentation automation, emphasizing how AI can save time and inspire innovation. The workshop echoed Tilak's emphasis on 'Education is important for nation and self-reliance', showing participants how AI can democratize knowledge, making learning and creativity accessible to all.

The workshop was inaugurated by paying heartfelt tribute to Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak and offering prayers to Goddess Saraswati, symbolizing the union of wisdom, knowledge, and inspiration in the presence of the Chief Guest, Upendra Joshi (Member, Swami Vivekanad Kendra), Chief Guest Mandar Thakur (History Head Of Department, Adarsh College) and our beloved Principal Dr. Sangeeta Pande who graced the occasion with inspiring words.

Chief Guest, Mandar Thakur Sir, who spoke about the educational life of Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak. He narrated how Tilak, a brilliant student, excelled in mathematics and Sanskrit, graduating from Deccan College, Pune, and later becoming one of the first graduates in India to earn a B.A. in Mathematics. He also studied law, earning an LLB degree, but chose the path of education and national awakening over personal gain. Thakur Sir emphasized how Tilak co-founded the Deccan Education Society and later the Fergusson College to provide quality education-rooted in Indian values.

The session featured an enlightening address by Chief Guest Upendra Joshi Sir, who emphasized the importance of time and effective time management. He explained that time is one of the most valuable resources in both education and personal growth, and how managing it wisely leads to discipline, productivity, and success.

Further workshop was conducted by B.Sc. IT coordinator Devashree Apte and Faculty member of IT Department Purva Patankar. She explained the concept of the *World Wide Web (WWW)*, describing what it is, its history, and its growing importance in today's world. She highlighted how the WWW connects people across the globe, making knowledge, information, and technology accessible to everyone. To make the session engaging, she shared relatable examples of Artificial Intelligence (AI) from both movies and daily life such as AI characters in films, voice assistants on smartphones, product recommendations on shopping sites, and smart home devices. These examples helped participants easily understand how AI has seamlessly blended into entertainment, education, and everyday living.

Devashree Apte Ma'am explained how to use modern AI tools like Chatbot's and Gamma AI, explaining how they simplify communication, automate tasks, and assist in creating presentations. She demonstrated Gamma AI in action by preparing a sample presentation on *E-waste*, showing how the tool can turn ideas into well-structured slides with design and content suggestions. Her explanation not only familiarized attendees with innovative AI solutions but also raised awareness about the issue of electronic waste and the importance of its responsible management.

With guidance from distinguished speakers, total 180 candidates not only learned about the technical aspects of AI tools like Chatbot's Gamma AI, and the World Wide Web, but also reflected on timeless values like discipline, time management, and the power of education as envisioned by Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak. The sessions blended modern technology with meaningful lessons, encouraging participants to embrace AI thoughtfully. The event concluded with a collective resolve to use these learnings to enhance education, communication, and contribute positively to society.
